**MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER
(Proceeding Terminated)**

By the Assistant Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau:

1. The Audio Division has before it the “Request for Approval of Withdrawal,” submitted on behalf of LKCM Radio Group, LP (“LKCM”) on April 2, 2008. Previously, LKCM had filed a petition for reconsideration of our dismissal of its counterproposal in this proceeding.¹ LKCM now requests approval to withdraw its petition for reconsideration. In support of its request, LKCM attaches a sworn declaration that no consideration has been paid or promised, directly or indirectly, for such withdrawal.²

2. It is the Commission’s policy to refrain from making an allotment to a community absent a continuing expression of interest. By filing its “Request for Approval of Withdrawal,” LKCM has demonstrated that it has no continuing interest in the allotment request set forth in its counterproposal.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the “Request for Approval of Withdrawal” submitted by LKCM Radio Group, LP, IS GRANTED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the petition for reconsideration and the counterproposal submitted by LKCM Radio Group, LP, in this proceeding, ARE DISMISSED.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.

6. This document is not subject to the Congressional Review Act. The Commission, is, therefore, not required to submit a copy of this Report and Order to the Government Accountability Office, pursuant to the Congressional Review Act, *see* 5 U.S.C. 801(a)(1)(A), because the proposed rule was dismissed.
